



## DANCE INSTRUCTORS NEEDED FOR 2017-18 SEASON

### WHO WE ARE

Christian Dance Alliance is an educational dance ministry, founded in 2012. We are a non-competitive dance studio providing quality, age-appropriate dance instruction in a Christian environment.

CDA offers classes in creative movement, ballet, pointe, jazz, dance conditioning, gross motor skills development and Christian worship dance. All classes are taught in a Christ-centered environment, with family-friendly and God-honoring music, movements and costumes. Our curriculum integrates classical dance technique with Scripture, contemporary Christian and classical music, choreographed routines as well as improvised and creative movement. In addition to dance classes, we offer two performing ministries (Guidance Dance Company and Arise & Shine Dance Company).

Our students range in age from 3 to 18. Classes are primarily held during the week – morning, afternoon and evenings – while some classes are held on Saturday mornings. Our studio season culminates in an annual Spring Production. Christian Dance Alliance is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization.

### JOB OPPORTUNITY

CDA is currently **hiring part-time dance instructors** (2-10 hours per week) for our next regular studio season (**September 2017 – May 2018**). Additional opportunities may be available June-August 2017.

In addition to weekly classes and Spring Production choreography, Instructors may have additional teaching, choreographing and performing opportunities with Guidance Dance Company, Arise & Shine Dance Company or as a part of special events.

### QUALIFICATIONS

CDA is seeking **experienced** dance instructors trained in **classical ballet** and/or **jazz**. Other dance disciplines welcome. Experience with Christian worship dance is greatly valued. BA or BFA in dance or comparable experience preferred. Minimum 3 years of teaching experience required. Applicants should be professional, reliable, friendly and passionate about working with young dancers. Instructors must also be able to comply with company guidelines.
